

## 4th Sunday of Easter


Today's Gospel occurs in the middle of Jesus' ministry. At first, Jesus' words seem to be about the value of self-sacrifice in a leader. "I am the Good Shepherd? I will lay down my life for the sheep." The Apostles likely would have accepted these words

easily enough. But then comes something more strange. "I lay down my life in order to take it up again? I have power to lay it down and power to take it up again." Only later, when Jesus opened the Scriptures to them after his resurrection, would the Apostles understand his words. Only then would they understand why such an act was necessary for the salvation of the world.



Even now, we may struggle with the necessity of Holy Week. How often do we hear complaints against the silence of God, as if He is the "hired man" who "runs away" from suffering? Jesus' life, death, and resurrection is our redemption in fact. God himself bears the full weight of sin's consequences. The Paschal Mystery is also a sign that happens in full view of the human experience. We have seen Jesus lay down his life. We have seen him accompany others. "I know mine and mine know me." We have seen him reach those outside the traditional flock, "sheep not of this fold." Jesus is the Good Shepherd, not only in Scripture but in our daily lives.

While we can't experience physically walking alongside him like the Apostles did, the grace of our redemption continues through the Church. We are shepherded by the sacraments, by faith formation, by good mentors. At the same time, we are not only the sheep. In imitating Jesus, we, too, are invited to lay down our lives for others. We can be the hands, feet, and shepherd's crook of Christ.



## **A Family Perspective**

Today's Gospel is a job description for Christian parents. For most people, the most influential shepherds in their lives are their PARENTS. Every parent is called to be a "good shepherd" to "freely lay down their life" for their children, to "love" and "know" their children and to "lead" them so "they know your voice."



## April 25th, St. Mark the Evangelist

Much of what we know of St. Mark comes from the New Testament and early Christian traditions. Mark the Evangelist is believed to be the "John Mark' referred to in the Acts of the Apostles. Mark was the son of Mary of Jerusalem whose home became a meeting place

for the apostles; he is also a cousin of Barnabas.

He joined St. Paul and St. Barnabas on their first missionary journey to Antioch in 44 AD. He soon returned to Jerusalem missing his home city. Paul believed that Mark would not be a good missionary if he was missing his home. Paul refused to allow Mark to accompany him on his second journey to the churches of Asia Minor. This mistrust ended upon Paul's imprisonment in Rome when Mark visited him frequently while he was planning a return trip to Asia Minor.

Mark did return to Asia Minor and in time came back to Rome and was probably there when Paul was martyred. Mark's own martyrdom came at the hands of a mob dragging him through the streets of Alexandria where he lived for many years and established the Church of Alexandria. Mark wrote his Gospel between 60 and 70 AD which was based on the teachings of St. Peter. Mark, like Luke, was not an apostle but learned of Jesus's teachings through Peter.

In 828, the relics of St. Mark were stolen from Alexandria and taken to Venice. They are enshrined in the beautiful cathedral dedicated to him. Mark's symbol is a winged lion. He is often depicted as writing or holding his Gospel. He is also shown as a bishop on a throne or as a man helping Venetian sailors. St. Mark is the patron saint of Venice.




